Sunday, March 15—The Welcome Reception

Monday, March 16—Ironwood Ranch Horseback Ride

At Ironwood Ranch, we do the West Maui Journey, a 90 minute horseback ride which will take us through tropical valleys and ironwood forests. The route will vary based on conditions, but always scenic and fun! This ride is recommended for all riding levels. We have scheduled two rides: 1:00 p.m. (depart the hotel at 11:30 a.m.) and a 3:00 p.m. (depart the hotel at 12:30 p.m.). It is 55 minute drive without traffic.

Tuesday, March 17—FREE DAY Ka'anapali Snorkel and Whale Watching

Ka'anapali is ideally located for enjoying many ocean adventures. It is the only location where pick up and drop off is directly from the beach. Some of Maui's best snorkel sites are only a few miles away and the crew will choose the best destination for that day. Experienced and dedicated crew are masters of teaching first time snorkelers. All snorkeling equipment and instruction will be provided, as well as a continental breakfast, lunch, soda and snacks, and that personalized service you've come to expect from Maui's first family of sailing. With those famous Maui tradewinds just a few hundred yards off shore, the crew wastes no time in hoisting sail and getting into some serious sailing to see if we can find any whales before our return. Check in is at 7:45 a.m. (for the 8:00 a.m. sail) at the Trilogy Ocean Sports Beach kiosk on the beach fronting Ka'anapali Beach Hotel. Without traffic, it is a 15 minute drive.

Wednesday, March 18—Zip n' Dip at Ka'anapali Zipline

Experience the ultimate Zipline tour adventure which includes Maui's only Zip n' Dip line, allowing you to splash into a natural mountain pool. Race your family or friends on our double racing line while enjoying sweeping views of the Pacific Ocean, offshore islands and West Maui Mountains. The dip is optional. If you choose not to, simply relax and get a tan! Check in is at 1:00 p.m. for the 1:30 p.m. two and a half hour tour. Without traffic, it is a 15 minute drive.

Thursday, March 19—ATV Tour

Experience the excitement of driving your own ATV through an active cattle ranch on dirt roads and trails inaccessible to the general pubic. Enjoy the breathtaking views of Lahaina Town and surrounding Hawaiian Islands. Nestled in the picturesque West Maui Mountains above the town of Lahaina on 600 acres of unspoiled land, Kahoma Ranch provides the perfect playground for your adventure. Experienced guides take you on an exhilarating ride on your own twoperson Polaris ATV up into the pastures where you may come across cows, horses, and even peacocks or the occasional pig. Check in is at 1:30 p.m. for the 2:00 p.m. tour. Check in location is in Lahaina which is a 15 minute drive without traffic.


