2014 MCM TOPICS

APRIL: Applications to Terminations

In this seminar we will examine the cycle of residency from the initial point of contact when a person inquires about residency to the last contact with a resident in various scenarios that may involve a resident's exit from your community. The speaker panel will include a management expert and industry attorney.

MAY: Park Operations: Understanding the Big Picture

This seminar will focus on what every manufactured housing community owner/operator should know when it comes to park operations. We will approach a variety of topics with consideration for what it means to the community –the business- and what it means to your residents. We will breakdown some of the main components of operating your community and discuss best practices and legal considerations with each subject. Topics include the laws, rental agreements, rents, rules and regulations, park inspections, home sales, evictions, park closures, and the most important component of your business – your residents. This seminar extends an excellent educational opportunity for those new to manufactured housing community management and/or ownership. Experienced managers and owners in attendance are encouraged to approach each subject through the eyes of their residents and share procedures and techniques that yield positive outcomes for the business and for residents. The speaker panel will include a management expert and industry attorney.

AUGUST: Common Resident Issues

In this seminar we will present a series of questions for discussion and answers. Join us and learn the finer points of approaching the most common concerns of residents and management-resident conflicts. Questions target topics such as maintenance complaints, dogs, rule enforcement, turning down a prospective purchaser, heirs, lot lines, rentals, and resident meetings. Hear tips on how to avoid unnecessary conflicts and leave with some new thoughts on how to develop and operate your community to the highest potential. The speaker panel will include a management expert and industry attorney.
