Monday, April 29—Kona Coffee Roast Master Tour

This tour starts at the Mountain Thunder Coffee Plantation Visitors' Center for Kona coffee and Hawaiian tea tasting. While enjoying samples, we will view Discovery Channel's feature about Kona coffee. It was filmed at Mountain Thunder's Kaloko cloud forest farm. The show takes you through the processes from seed to cup. After the showing, we go to the dry mill located next to the Visitors' Center. At the dry mill, you will learn about hulling, sizing, grading, and color sorting of the different grades of Kona coffee. This is where you will see what separates world famous Mountain Thunder's Kona Coffee from the rest. Once you have learned how the raw green beans are prepared to roast, it's off to roasting school. You will get an extensive hands-on experience as Roast Master for a day. You will get to roast a pound of true Kona coffee and take it home!

Tuesday, April 30—Flumin' Da Ditch

This is Hawaii's most cultural and historical adventure! A completely new and ultimate eco-adventure floating in mountain kayaks exploring the famed Kohala Ditch System. Our tour begins with a very cool off-road excursion on our custom Pinzgauers to our launch site high in the Kohala Mountains. Immersed in a jungle setting, a short hike over a 150 foot flume overlooking a waterfall and a fascinating earth tunnel is the prelude to our kayak journey. We board our kayaks and cruise for 2 ½ miles through a Hawaiian rainforest, ten earth tunnels, water flumes and native flora and fauna. Knowledgeable fifth generation native guides will share genuine history and Hawaiian folklore. Experience three tours in one awesome package! Fascinating, educational and true Hawaiian beauty! The tour begins at 12:30 p.m. We will depart from the hotel at 11:30 a.m. Plan your lunch prior to departure. Wear water shoes, tennis shoes or sandals with a strap. No flip flops! You will spend two and one-half hours of fun at historic Kealakekua Bay. The Fair Wind II features two 15-foot water slides and a high jump platform from the top deck! While at the Bay, the captain fires up the grill on the boat and cooks Fair Wind cheeseburgers and garden burgers for lunch—the tastiest cheeseburgers in paradise that even Jimmy Buffet has only dreamed of!
