In 2007 Peter was named Entrepreneur of the Year by the *East Bay Business Times* and in 2009 the *San Francisco Business Times* awarded him The Most Admired CEO for a small business. Arborwell operates throughout California with locations in Hayward, Redwood City, Sacramento, San Diego, Orange County and San Jose. Peter is a member of The Alliance of CEO's and a board member of The Tree Care Industry Association. Peter lives in San Mateo CA with his wife Anne and has two sons Alex and Tom who attend college at Ashland University of Ohio and The University of Alabama.
